She was very organized on her lectures, and she was always encouraged participation and questions in class. Everything from having to follow instructions and doing homework, to the labs, was great and helpful in furthering our understanding of the class overall. Overall, I loved the professor, I'm really going to miss it. *** Professor Ceberio is terrible, she calls you stupid and has poor communication and explanation skills. *** Great introductory course, great instructor, but I miss a subject, everything is well explained. *** I've had 3 years of programming experience and my decision to take this introductory course is to get great fundamental skills. I didn't appreciate the professor calling me dumb when I asked a question. I've asked 5 questions all year, 3 were incomplete, and 2 were incorrect information.
